

# SUNDOWN ROUGHNECK BAND

## OVERNIGHT TRAVEL RULES

1. All school district policies apply during the trip. School policy prohibits students from using or possessing alcohol, drugs, or tobacco. Violation of any school rules or Roughneck Band rules may result in the student being dismissed from the trip, in the student being suspended from all extra-curricular activities for the remainder of the school year, and in other disciplinary actions as prescribed by school policy.
2. Students are to follow the itinerary closely and are to report to the assigned places at the assigned times *without being late*. Students are to be in their *own* rooms at the assigned time and are to have lights out at the assigned time. Students are not to leave their rooms for any reason after room check.
3. Students involved in any action which results in damage to or loss of hotel property will be held financially liable. Such an event will also result in disciplinary action.
4. Under no circumstances are boys allowed in girls' rooms or girls allowed in boys' rooms at any time. Only band members, directors, or designated chaperones are allowed in any of our hotel rooms. Any outside visitors (i.e. family members living in the area, etc.) must be approved by the band director and are to remain in the hotel lobby. Visitors must leave the hotel when students are to return to their rooms for the evening.
5. Students are not to leave the hotel property for any reason unless they are accompanied by a director or a designated chaperone. Any violation of this will result in dismissal from the trip.
6. As a courtesy to other guests, noise levels in the hotel, both in rooms and in hallways, shall be kept to an absolute minimum!
7. Students are to be respectful to chaperones and are to follow their directions at all times. Failure to do so shall result in loss of privileges during the trip. Repeated failure to do so shall result in dismissal from the trip.
8. Be polite and courteous to the employees of the establishments we patronize. Loud, obnoxious, or rude behavior will not be tolerated.
9. Proper attire will be expected. *The Sundown High School dress code is in effect at all times while on this trip.* If you have any questions about this, check it out with a director before we leave.
10. Students should realize they are representing Sundown High School, the Roughneck band, and the city of Sundown at all times. Proper behavior is expected! Let's continue our tradition of excellence!!!
