

Roughneck Band Travel Itinerary

UIL Region 16 Marching Contest

Saturday, Oct. 20, 2007 – Lowrey Field, Lubbock

- All band members must report to the band hall dressed in your band shirt **before 9:00 a.m.**
- Make sure you have long, white socks!!!
- We will eat in Lubbock before we perform.
- Your instrument and shoes should be cleaned and polished before we leave for Lubbock.
- MAKE SURE YOUR NAME IS LABELED ON ALL INSTRUMENTS, UNIFORM BAGS, AND HAT BOXES. You will be instructed where to place these items outside the buses so the loading crew can load them. The loading crew will not come and get your instrument or uniform from the band hall. It is your responsibility to take these items to the designated bus yourself. NO ONE WILL DO THIS FOR YOU!!! (Cheerleaders, trainers, and varsity football players must make certain to have your complete uniforms.)
- When we arrive at the stadium, please listen for directions. DO NOT play on or make any sound on your instrument until instructed to do so.
- Class A competition begins at 11:15 a.m. We perform at 2:10 p.m. Encourage your parents and friends to come support us. There is a \$3 admission charge for adults and \$1 for students.
- Lowrey Field is located on the corner of 66th St. and Ave. P in Lubbock. The easiest route to the stadium is to take South Loop 289 to University, and then head north on University to 66th St. Turn right (east) on 66th which will take you directly to the stadium parking lot.
- After we perform we will change out of uniform back into our band shirts and then return to the stadium, sit as a group, and watch the remainder of the Class A bands. Once Class A results are announced (sometime around 5:00), we will return to the buses and leave for Sundown.
- All students must take school provided transportation to Lubbock. If you are planning to return home with your parents, you must take your instrument home with you and make arrangements for someone to return your uniform to the uniform storage room. Do not leave these items for us to keep up with.
- If you are planning to return home with your parents, you may leave only after results have been announced. Your parent(s) must sign you out with Mr. Eakins.
- When we return home, the loading crew will unload equipment from under each bus. You will then be released to pick up your instrument and uniform, and carry them to their proper places in the band hall. DO NOT go home without putting your equipment and uniform away. The loading crew will not do this for you. Loading crew members may not leave until they have checked out with one of the directors.
- Our approximate return time is 6:00 p.m. This is only an estimate.
